You could try.....

- ◆ putting on different faces and asking you child which ones look furious.
- ◆ looking at a book or as you walk outside asking your child what they think is fascinating.



What do the words mean?

event — An event is a special thing that happens.

You usually have to plan and do things to get ready for an event.

preparations — Preparations are all the things we do to get ready for something like a party.

furious — If you are furious you are very very angry.

fascinated — If you are fascinated you think something is very very interesting.

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
